



# **Assembly instructions**

- Strip to 9mm length and take off the cable jacket.
- Bead pressing strew, pinch ring, seal and distance sleeve to cable.
- Strip the insulation off the wires (1 = 3mm) and tin them.
- 4. Solder inserts.
- Fut bayonet adapter to the thread of the distance sleeve and screw it with slight pressure in the direction of the arrow.
- 6. Push pinch ring over sealing ring to block.
- Push pressing screw together with clamp-sealing unit towards distance sleeve and screw tightly.

### Security notices

The connector must not be plugged or unplugged under load. Non-observance and improper use can result in personal injury.

Connectors which are used in circuits with voltages dangerous to the touch may only be installed and used by, or under the supervision of, persons with electrical engineering training, taking into account the applicable regulations and standards.
